What excites you about the future of HIT?

I am most excited about the intersection of data from the EMR, CCD, and utilization data. Working from both a public good and patient perspective, the ability to predict disease states and work with providers to improve the overall health status of the community is within our reach today.



What do you see as the biggest challenges?

The biggest challenges facing the industry remain security and privacy. The risk of data breaches and protecting patient privacy remains the top priority of the providers from both internal and external actors.

A new challenge that is beginning to emerge is the ethical dilemma which will be created through the application of new technologies in healthcare. Specifically within machine learning, is it appropriate to alert a patient about an increasing health risk if they have not requested to be contacted? Alternatively, is the provider at risk for not sharing information about a potential disease with their patient if they become aware of the issue? These are new questions for most of us, and we need to think through the applicability of new technologies on society.

What was your favorite recent TN HIMSS activity or event?

The national HIMSS conference and TN HIMSS reception. It was a great opportunity to catch up with old friends and to make new contacts. There is no other event where you can see all of the players and their technologies in one day. It was particularly rewarding this year since TN HIMSS was recognized as the Chapter of the Year and Tommy Lewis received the Chapter Leader of the Year award. The TN HIMSS Board has worked very hard to execute on our strategic plan.
