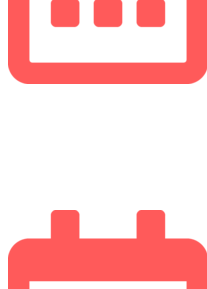

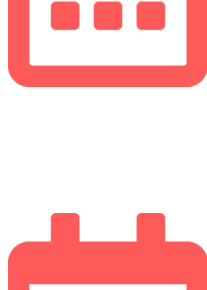

What has been your favorite TN HIMSS activity or event during your time as a member?

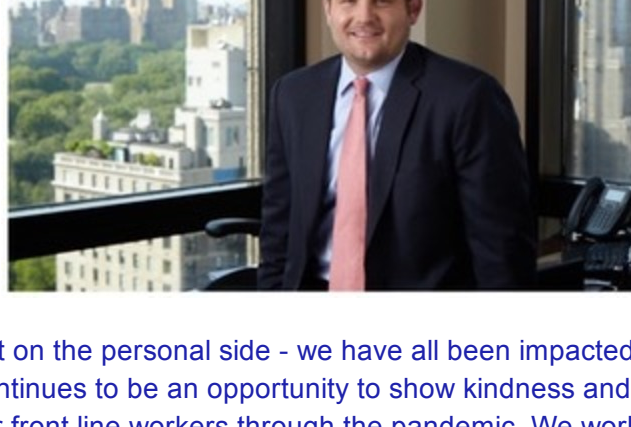

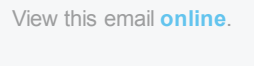
