Peter Embi, MD, MS

Professor & SVP of Research & Innovation, Vanderbilt University Medical Center

What do you see as the biggest challenges and opportunities in HIT?

Increasingly vast and growing amounts of health-related data have the potential to drive better data-driven



decisions using approaches like artificial intelligence. But data are often fraught with challenges, including poor data quality and inherent biases in the data that we must account for lest we inadvertently cause harm instead of benefit.

Another is the ongoing challenge of clinician burnout related to the less-than-optimal use of health IT solutions and the opportunities to improve efficiency and effectiveness through optimization of health IT implementations.

A third is the great opportunity to create data-driven learning health systems, so that we can learn from every patient and improve the care of individuals and populations tomorrow and well into the future via new discoveries and improvements in practice.

What do you see as the biggest value of being a TN HIMSS member?

There's so much we can and must do in order to fully leverage the incredible power and

capabilities of our health IT ecosystem in and across Tennessee.

The greatest value I see is the opportunity to gather and discuss the pressing needs we're all working to tackle, sharing of experiences, and finding opportunities to work jointly to improve our collective IT capabilities for the benefit of our organizations and the community as a whole.

We are definitely stronger together, and TN HIMSS provides a home for HIT professionals, focusing on our local and regional needs across systems and institutions more than a national organization.

What has been your favorite TN HIMSS activity or event during your

time as a member?
